Parents Right-to-Know

- ♦ Qualifications of Teachers
- ♦ Status of Teachers Not Highly-Qualified

(A) QUALIFICATIONS- At the beginning of each school year Learning Foundation and Performing Arts shall notify the parents of each student attending that they may request information regarding the professional qualifications of the student's classroom teachers including the following:

- Whether the teacher has met the Highly Qualified NCLB/ESEA requirements for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction.
- The baccalaureate degree major of the teacher and any other graduate certification or degree held by the teacher and the field of discipline of the certification or degree.
- Whether their child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, the qualifications of the paraprofessionals.

(B) ADDITIONAL INFORMATION- In addition to the parents requested information; the school shall provide the following to each individual parent:

- Information on the level of achievement of the parent's child in each of the state academic assessments
- Timely notice that the parent's child has for four or more consecutive weeks been assigned to, or taught by a teacher who is not highly qualified.
